Introduction

IP Power 9858DX is a new generation of the Power Distribution Unit (PDU) & Remote Power Control (RPC) system. Its able to connect to the **WiFi** network plus **WPS** function for easy & quick set up a device to user's wireless home/office network and control in the network

With embedded web server and **HTTPS** protection , 9858DX supports higher grade security as working on Internet. User can control power easily and more safely through the web browser on Windows PC or on **Smartphone** like Internet Explorer (IE) , Firefox , Google Chrome , Safari (iOS) and Android system.

9858DX allows user to remote control power up to **4 separate** devices on/off via network . As support **SSL & SNMP**, user can use public email like Gmail / Hotmail / Yahoo Mail to get the email as the ON/OFF status change . User can also **control by e-mail** without doing port forwarding / port mapping and search the other IP Device in webpage directly .

Besides control through web browser , there is **Android Apps** name "**IP Power**" for Android user to control the outlet power turn ON / OFF and quick search device in LAN / WAN Android phone / touch panel . No PC system environment or emergency use for quick response in second.

Not only control manually, 9858DX supports **Auto Ping , Time Scheduler** which is more suitable for factory / commercial / office / home automation . There is LOG information & send LOG to assign IP (SYSLOG) in webpage.

9858DX has **QR code** of different network to log in fast and easy. User can search the other IP Device in webpage directly .

For system integrator, there are several popular developing tolls like **TelNet , SNMP** and HTTP Command (SDK) for 2nd development . **New function : Apply Own Language display in webpage.**

The various applications of the 9858DX includes:

Power Management, Server Management, Internet Controllable Timer, System Integration, Remote Power Control in Remote locations etc.

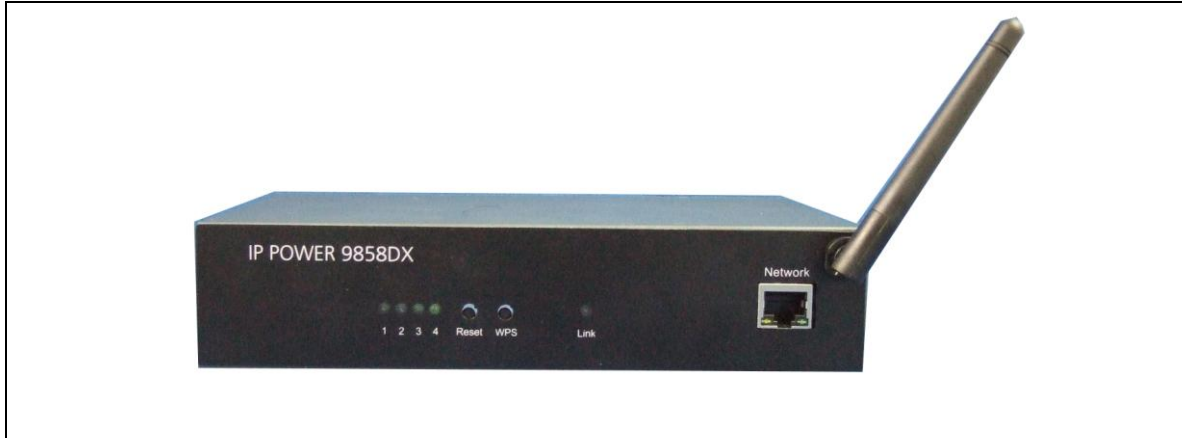

From Left to right :

Power Status Indicator:	The Power Status #1 ~ #4 Indicator - Green light ON as power ON.
Reset :	Set back to default setting by long press To reset to original manufacture settings, hold down the reset button with a sharpen pin for 5- 6 seconds then RELEASE. There are 3 beeps sound which means reset start and 9858DX will be rebooted itself -there is one beep after reboot) and most information go back to default setting (LAN IP).
WPS :	Enable WPS function by one short click There is one long beep as enable WPS function. Please refer page #13 for details.
Link:	The Link Indicator shows the WiFi signal transfer status. The light will be ON all the time and flashing while transfer data.
Network: LAN	LAN 10/100 Mbps network
Network :WIFI	WIFI 802.11N-B/G

In this socket, there is power input and Fuse socket .

- The input power sends power to the 9858DX.
- **Fuse** : To prevent electrical surges from damaging the unit. The 9858DX comes with one spare fuse in the unit.

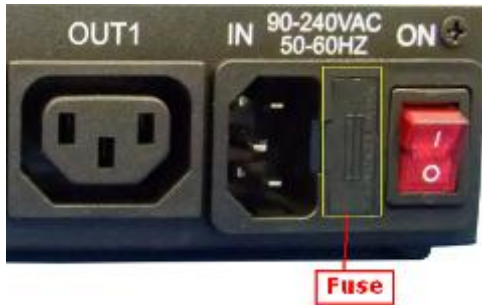
1 Power Switch:

Fuse replacement

1.) The fuse is located between the power switch and the power input plugs.

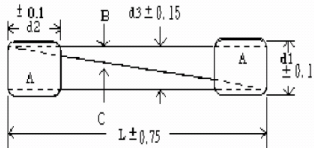


2.) Carefully remove the fuse holder with a flat screwdriver.



3.) The fuse can be purchased from electronic shops.

Setting up your device

Before Starting

*Before setting up the device make sure of the following:

- 1.) All the package contents are all included if anything is missing please contact the dealer where the device was purchased from.
- 2.) Check the power input cable is working correctly.
- 3.) Check all cables to make sure there are no problems with it.

Hardware Connection

Please refer following procedure :

- 1.) Connect the Ethernet cable (RJ45) to the 9858DX to your local area network.
- 2.) Then connect the power cable into the power input port of the 9858DX.
- 3.) Connect the device that you would like to control to the output plug on the top of the 9858DX.
- 4.) Switching the power source to ON status , this switch is located at the rear of 9858DX.
- 5.) After power on for around 45 seconds , there is a short beep sound for 9858DX which means the system reboot successfully
- 6.) Go to page #14 for software installation guide – use IP EDIT to log in the webpage of 9858DX.

Note: To change the network setting for WiFi connection (if your Router without WPS function) , please go to page # 12 to setup the WiFi connection manually .

The **Media Link - IP Family CD** comes with the device , it has all the necessary software to run and setup the device.

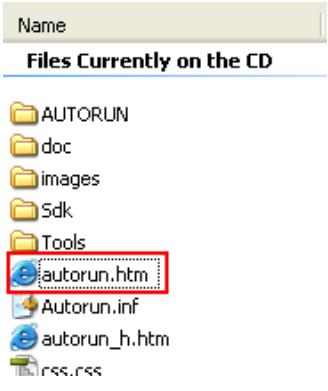

Installing Software

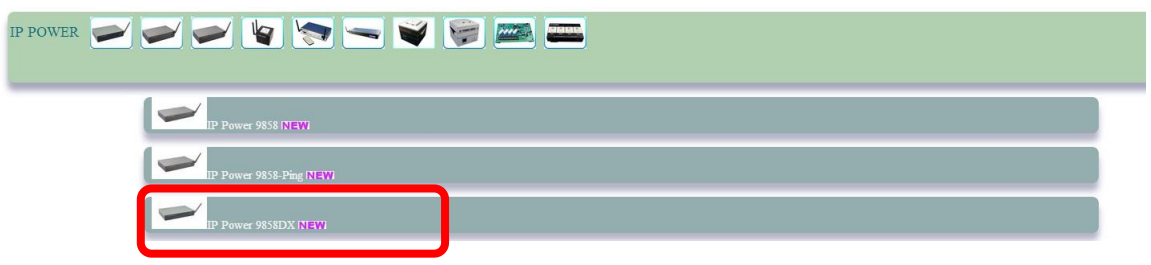
- 1.) Place the **Media Link-IP Family CD** into the CD/DVD Rom drive.
(The CD will auto run , but if it does not go to the CD/DVD Rom drive and select the “**autorun.html**” file.)



2.) Click on the IP Power Section Bar



3.) Select the IP Power 9858DX



4.) All the available downloads for the 9858DX will be shown



- 5.) Download the required software – **IPedit.exe** - by clicking on the download button.



Then you can select to connect 9858DX by LAN or by WAN (WPS)



Connection by WiFi- WPS (WiFi Protection Service)

IP Power 9858DX has WPS function , which can assist user setup the WiFi connection from user`s router and IP Power 9858DX automatically & fast . Before using WPS function, please check your WiFi router and see if there has WPS function first . There should have a button name “WPS / QCC “ or a sign on the router for user to click easily.

Please refer following steps to setup WiFi –WPS connection

Step 1: Power on the 9858DX - only connect power in but do not connect the LAN cable , you will hear one short beep in 40 seconds means 9858DX boot successfully

Step 2: Press the “WPS button” of your WiFi Router. (Please check your router WPS function)



Step 3 : One short press on the “ WPS ” button of 9858DX and then there is one long beep sound which means the WPS function of 9858DX is enabled .

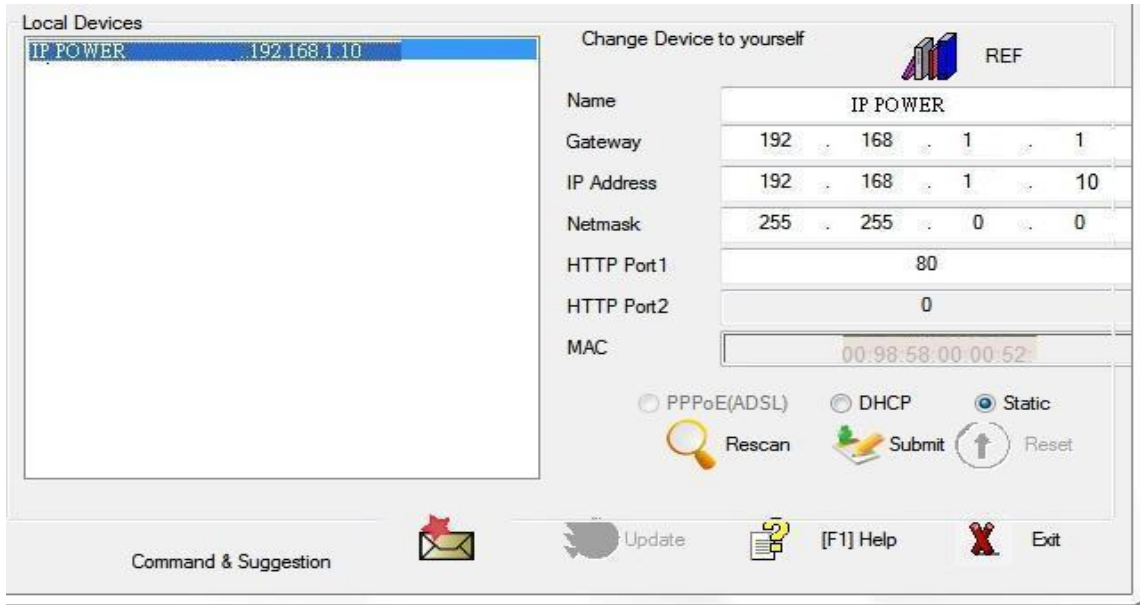


Step 4: After few seconds , there are 2 short beep Which means WPS connection successfully (If WPS connection fail , there is one long beep sound mean the connection fail. Please go back to step 2 and try again)

WPS Quick procedure :

One short press “ WPS “ button on 9858DX → One Short beep → 5-10 seconds → short 2 beeps → WPS connection successful

Step 5 : Execute IPEDIT.exe . There is WiFi IP address of 9858DX shown in IPEDIT.exe as following : Device name in local devices area is “ IP POWER (w)



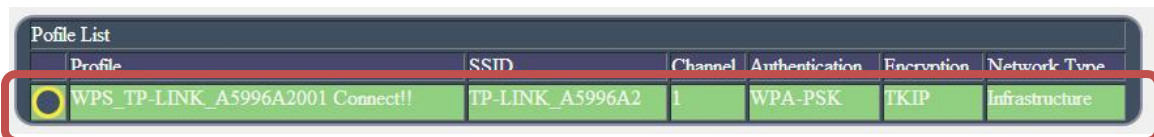
If can't see the IP in the area of Local Devices of IPEDIT.exe. Please disable the Firewall and Anti Virus software temporarily and try again .

Step 7 : Double click the IP address and your PC will execute web browser like IE ,Firefox or Google Chrome and there is wizard pop up to enquire the Username and Password .

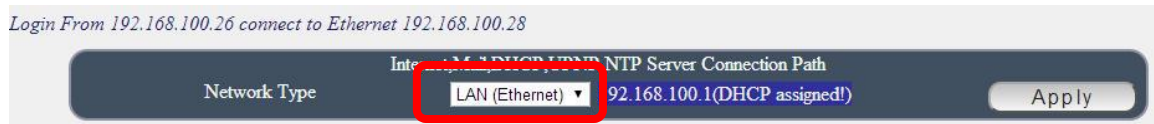

Step 8 : For the WiFi connection by WPS way , user can check here :
Network → WiFi Info → Profile list



To make this WiFi IP Address can be found on Internet, please arrange 2 settings as log in the 9858DX webpage:

1st : Go to “ Network → Setting → Default Network Type (gateway) Setting “ and change as WiFi for the Default Network Type (gateway) Setting .



2nd : Do the Port Mapping / Port Forwarding in your router (Need to check the router owner's manual).

Connecting first by LAN –Network cable then setup for WiFi connection

Without WPS , user can use LAN network cable to connect 9858DX first .

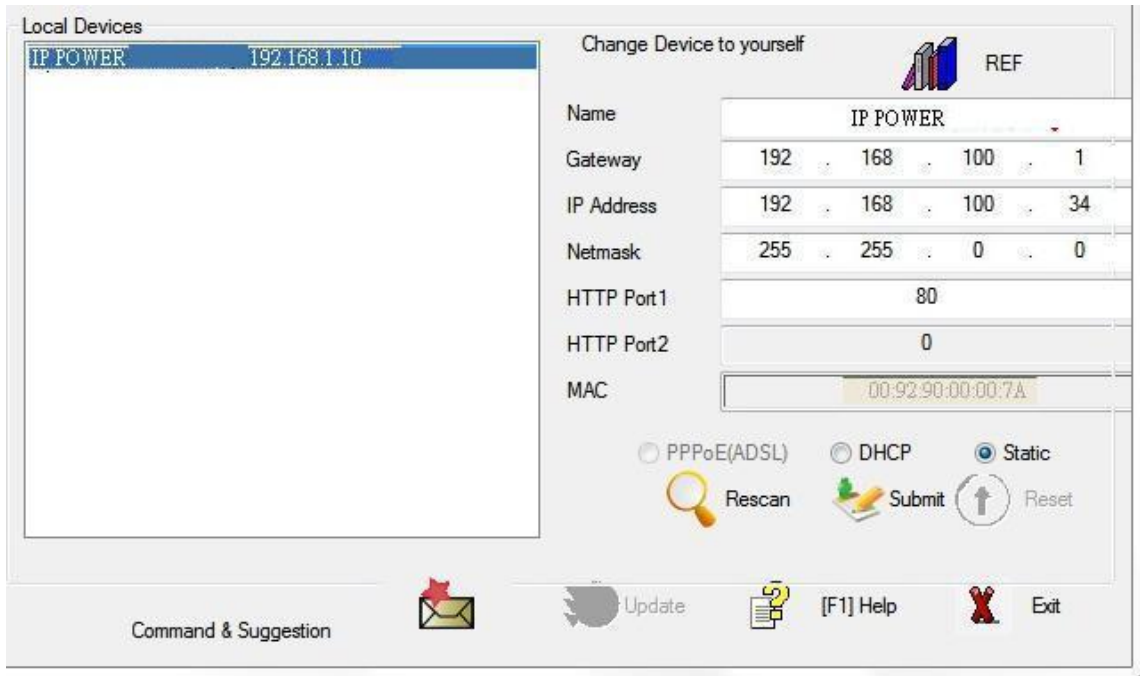

1.) In the local devices section user will see user device show up if connection correctly.



If can't see the IP in the area of Local Devices of IPEDIT.exe. Please disable the Firewall and Anti Virus software temporarily and try again.

- 2.) Select the 9858DX device and the device information will pop up on the right.
- 3.) Check to see that the gateway IP and the IP Address (9858DX) match user current network.

If not, type in the correct information, then hit the submit button to save changes.

For example:

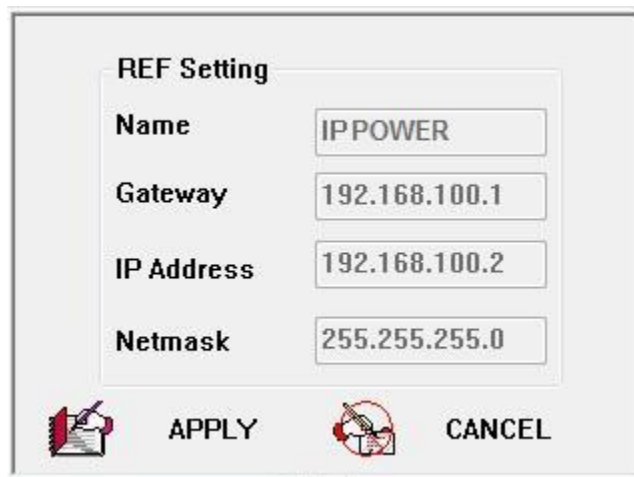
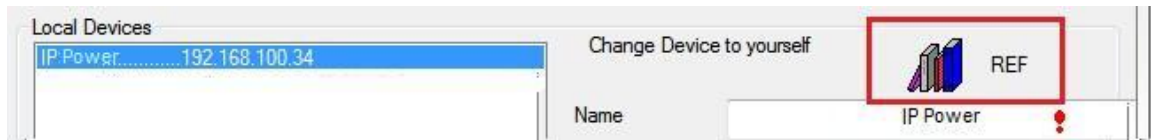
- 4.) Press the “ Rescan “ button to see if changes have been made.
- 5.) Double click on the device in the local device section and an IE web browser with the device login will pop up.
- 6.) Type in the default Login and IP Address to enter the device.

Segment : The first 9 digits of the IP Address .

EX: The IP of user PC is 192.168.100.122. If the “ Local IP Address “ at WiFi Info is 192.168.100.x (X can the value of 1~252) , user PC can get into the webpage of 9858DX .

Please press “Rescan “ to search the router near by again if can not see user router in the list.

After log in 9858DX , to connect by WiFi , please go to Network → WiFi Survey to add the WiFi router in to 9858DX WiFi profile .

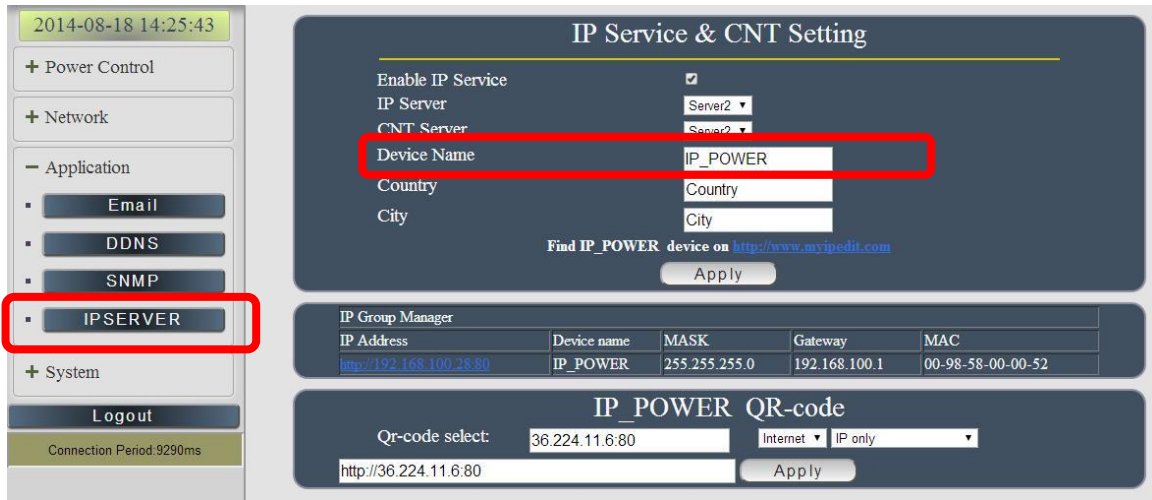

Using IP Server

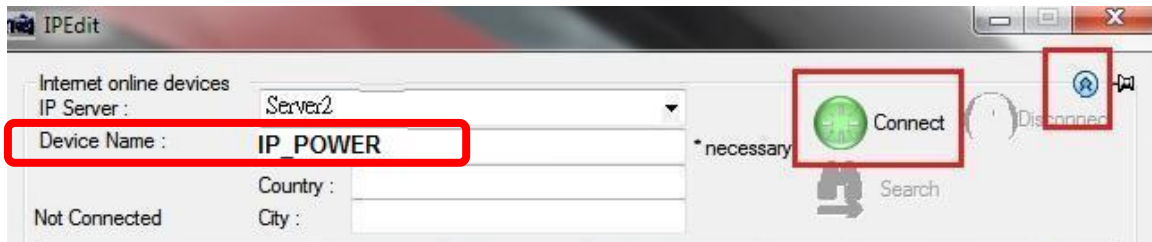
IP Server is a function which allows user to search for the device easily without having to remember long complicated IP address. Instead, if user know the device's name of user IP Power device and user can easily find IP Address with IP Service. **To log in the webpage of 9858DX on Internet , user still need to do the "Port Forwarding " in own router.**

Before using "IP Server " , please change the device name of user 9858DX to avoid similar name in Host Server.



1.) Open IP Edit and select the server that user's 9858DX is designated to.

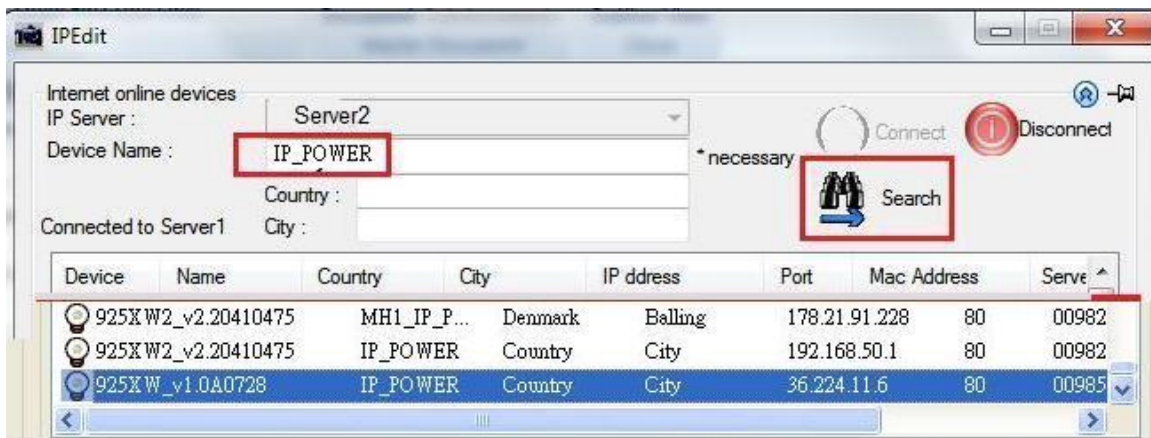
2.) Hit the Green Connect button on the top of IP Edit.



3.) Then type in the 9858DX Name that user have selected for the device and press the Search button.

4.) Find user device and double click on the screen and a IE window will pop up connecting to user device. *User device must be Port Forwarded for the login screen to appear.

EX: The 9858DX device name as IP_POWER , and user can search the device easily :



5.) After user have connected to user device, type in the Login and Password for user device

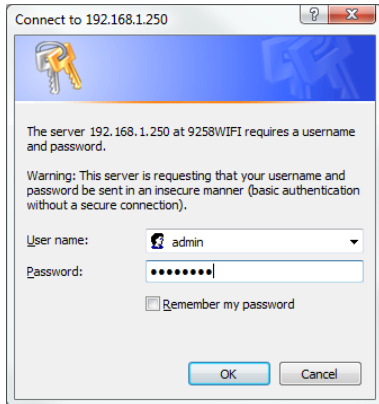
Once the 9858DX has been setup correctly, log into the device.

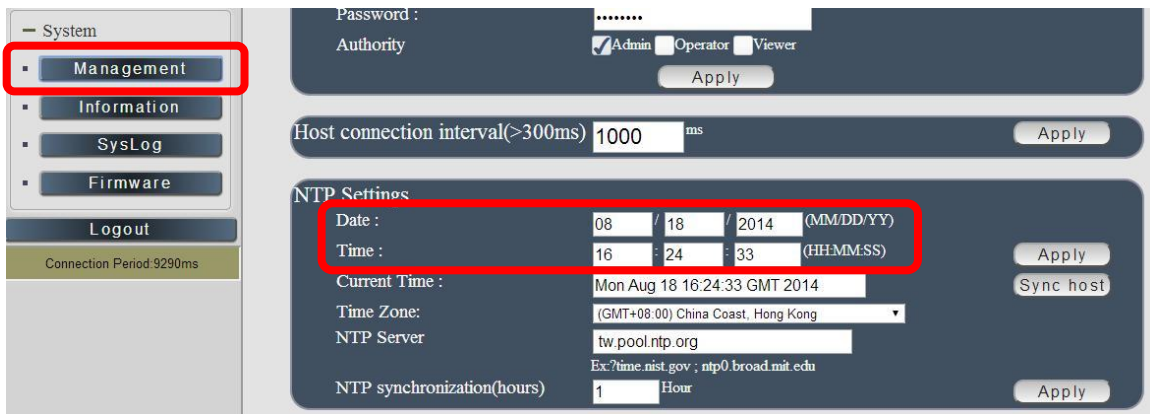

In this section, it shows Time at Year – Month – Date Hours : Minutes : Seconds .



To setup the Time , Please go to “ System → Management → NTP Settings “ , please press “Apply” to save the new setting .



IO Control :

The IO Control Section allows you to directly / automatically control the outlets of the 9858DX as well as schedule Daily, Weekly, and Monthly power cycles.

There are 5 section : Control , Schedule , Ping , Timeline and History.



Control

There are 2 setting pages in this Section. One is “ Power Control “ and another one is “Advance Setup “

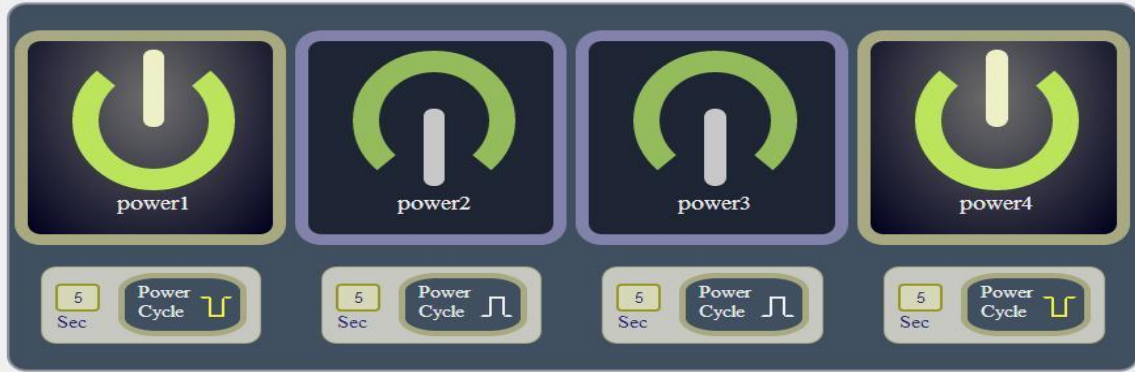
A. Power Control :

User can do the following 3 basic operation in this page :

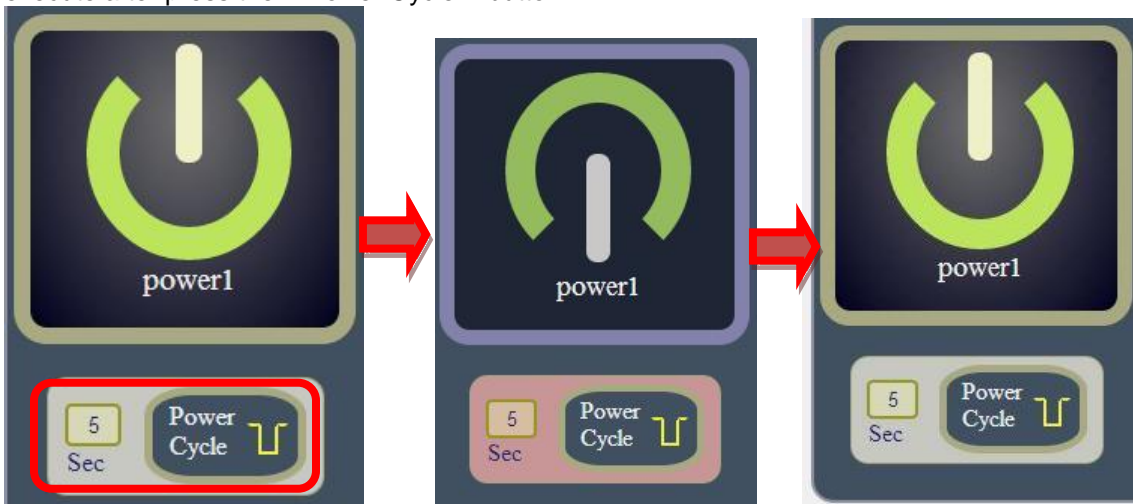
1. Manual control each port ON or OFF directly by pressing the power sign.
2. Power Cycle : This section allow user to setup the output Reset action.
The cycle time from OFF to ON can be set from 1 to 99 seconds
 - Original Status as ON : Press “Apply” then the outlet will turn OFF → ON .
 - Original Status as OFF : Press “Apply” then the outlet will turn ON → OFF →ON.
3. Group Setting : User can control more than one outlet by press the right side “Apply “ button . For safety concern , each port of 9858DX will turn ON or OFF one after one .



For example : The following pictures means that Power #1 & #4 is ON , Power #2 & #3 is OFF



The following 3 pictures shows that after press the power cycle with 5 seconds setting , the outlet “ Power1 “ will turn off for 5 seconds , then turn ON later . The power cycle action will execute after press the “ Power Cycle “ button .



B. Advance Setup :

User can do the following 2 advance operation in this page :

- Alarm Setting :

- E-mail Alarm Setting :

User can enable /disable the e-mail alarm here .The e-mail alarm section allows 9858DX to notify user by following situation :

- Receive E-mail with IP information & MAC Address as 9858DX device boot up.

- 10) **Reboot and Do the Hardware Reset** (keep pressing RESET button for 10secs) after update successfully.
- 11) **Clear the Cookies** to avoid get the old webpage .

CGI Commands allow you to easily integrate the 9858DX with other systems and programs. Please read the instructions carefully on how to use the Http:// Commands

To use http:// Commands open up a web browser and type in the command that you would like to use.

1. User authorization .There are 3 formats :

For example : IP address 192.168.1.18 , Username : admin. Password : 12345678

2. Command

All command do not separate capital / lower case , the connect symbol between commands can be “+” , “&” and “?” .

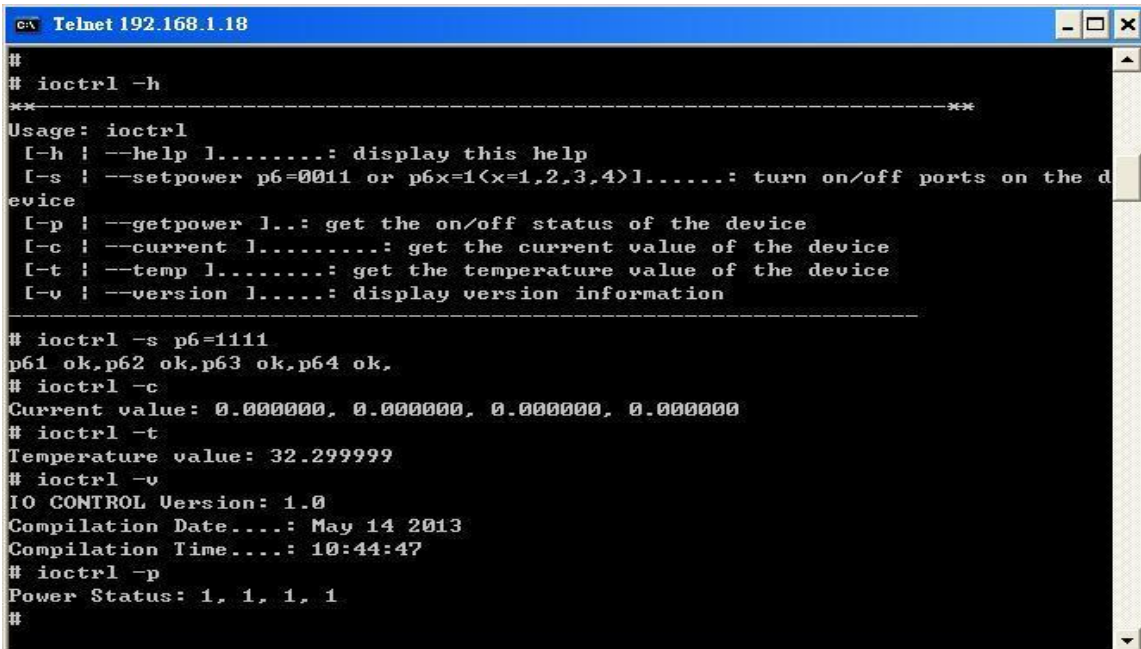

Notice: The command “-C “ & “-T “ are for models 9858DX only .

FAQ :

**Q1: Why can I see 2 IP address on IPEDIT.exe but can only reach one ?
Why did IPEDIT.exe show the LAN IP address as no network cable connect ?
Why did IPEDIT.exe show the WIFI IP address as no WIFI router available ?**

Ans.: 9858DX will remember the LAN / WAN setting one connect .Please select the IP you can log into 9858DX to operate.

There is no problem if connect both LAN and WAN

But the Gateway Setting will affect as working on Internet and also sending / receiving e-mail . User must select the correct Gateway as need to get into 9858DX on Internet

Q2 : Why can't I see my 9858DX after arrange the port forwarding in my router?

Ans. : Please make sure the Network Type (Gateway) is correct - LAN or WAN .

Q3 : Why can't I receive e-mail ?

Ans.: Please check the setting first and then make sure the DNS is correct (Check your router or ask your ISP company) .There is a test button for checking the setting success or fail to send e-mail.

Q4: Why can't I get the IP in IPEDIT by LAN after delete WiFi profile or lost WiFi AP connection ?

Ans.: If the WiFi connection for 9858DX lost or the WiFi AP router damage, 9858DX can't get the WiFi IP then it will change it's IP to fixed IP address as **192.168.1.168** .

User can't see the IP by IPEDIT as the Network type is still at WiFi .

There will have 2 ways re-log in 9858DX -- by WiFi and by LAN . :

BY WiFi connection : Please reboot 9858DX and Re-connect 9858DX with new WiFi router by " WPS " button (can do this way without 9258 W2 power reboot)

BY LAN connection :

Please refer following step :

Step1: Please connect 9858DX to your PC directly and change the IP address of your PC as 192.168.1.xxx (set the IP of your PC to be the same segment of 9858DX .)
xxx can be 1~255 but not 168 .

Step 2 : After log in to the 9858DX in LAN, please go to Network → Setting → Default Network Type setting to change the Network type from " WiFi " to " LAN " and click "Apply" .

The NETWORK TYPE is the door for Internet connection , E-mail , DHCP UPNP NET Server . Please select correct TYPE LAN or WAN for the user to log in 9858DX form Internet and use above functions .



Notice :

Under DHCP mode - either select LAN or WiFi connection, 9858DX will get the Network type (Gateway) information automatically. But if under Static mode , please do fill up the correct Network type (gateway) . As choose WiFi connection , the Network type (gateway) of LAN will be empty automatically.

Step 3 : Connect your PC and 9858DX to a router by LAN. Then **reboot 9858DX (MUST DO)** . After 45 seconds with a long beep sound , you can find the LAN IP of 9858DX by IPEIDT.exe

Q5: How can I reset to default:

Ans : Keep pressing the button of "RESET" for 5 seconds at least

To reset to original manufacture settings : press the reset button with a sharpen pin for 5- 6 seconds then RELEASE. There will be 3 beeps sound which means reset start and 9858DX will be rebooted itself -there is one beep after reboot) and most information go back to default setting (LAN IP).
